NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Council of the Municipal District of Foothills No. 31 will hold the required public hearing for the following application for an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw and redesignation of the subject lands beginning on **FEBRUARY 29th**, and if necessary, continuing on **MARCH 1st and 2nd, 2012** at the time indicated below, **please note a change in venue** – the public hearing will be held at the **HIGHWOOD MEMORIAL CENTRE, MEDICINE TREE HALL, 128 – 5 AVENUE W.**, High River, Alberta.

The complete file for the following application may be inspected in the Municipal Office in High River during regular office hours - Monday to Friday, 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M.

At each hearing the Council will hear from the Applicants, from any person who claims to be affected by the proposal, and from any other person who wishes to make representation **AND** that the Council agrees to hear.

A Resolution was passed by Council stating that all requests to adjourn or reschedule a public hearing be accompanied by a \$500.00 fee.

Any person providing a written submission at a hearing must have twelve copies of same available at the commencement of the hearing for the Councillors and the Secretary. If you wish to provide letters in advance of the hearing, please do so 2 days prior to the hearing date. Please make sure to include your name, the legal description of your land, and a signature. No submissions via telephone or e-mail will be considered.

A five minute time limit has been imposed on submissions and presentations to Council. Permission for additional time may be requested and may be granted at the discretion of the Chairman. After being presented all information at the hearing, the Council may either close the hearing, or they may adjourn the hearing, or they may table the hearing.

The below mentioned application is for an amendment to the Land Use Bylaw and redesignation of the subject lands.

Amendment to the Land Use Bylaw and redesignation from Agricultural & Country Residential District to Direct Control

Application from BFI Canada Inc. on behalf of the landowner, Patrick Colliton for the following:

1. Creation of a new Direct Control District in the Land Use Bylaw to allow for the Prairie Sky Resource Centre including a Class II Landfill facility, community recycling centre, material recovery facility, organic material composting, and an interpretive centre.
2. Redesignation of a portion of the parcels being Section 4 and 5-19-26 W4M from Agricultural and Country Residential Districts to Direct Control District land use rules to allow for the Prairie Sky Resource Centre including a Class II Landfill facility, community recycling centre, material recovery facility, organic material composting, and an interpretive centre.
