### **Dust Control – Spot Treatment Program/Policy**

---

#### **Policy Statement**

Residents may apply once a year for dust control on a municipal road in front of a residence free of charge for a distance of 100 meters. If a spot was done the previous year, and at the discretion of public works is still in good condition, no more will be done in the current year. The deadline date for requests for dust control/spot treatment will be July 31<sup>st</sup>.

The following circumstance will permit the Public Works department to apply an additional 100m of spot treatment on an adjacent road at the landowners sole cost:

1. Any parcel of land with an adjacent gravel road, where the primary residence is within 48 meters of the centerline of a municipal road or service road or within 15 meters from the road right of way on an internal subdivision road, may request that an additional 100 meters only of dust control be applied at their sole cost.
2. The municipality shall not accept any claim to compensate/repair/restore a spot treatment as a function of any activity that may damage the spot treatment. It is understood that the municipality reserves the right to turn any spot treatment back to gravel if it is the opinion of the Public Works department that the dust control is a road hazard.
