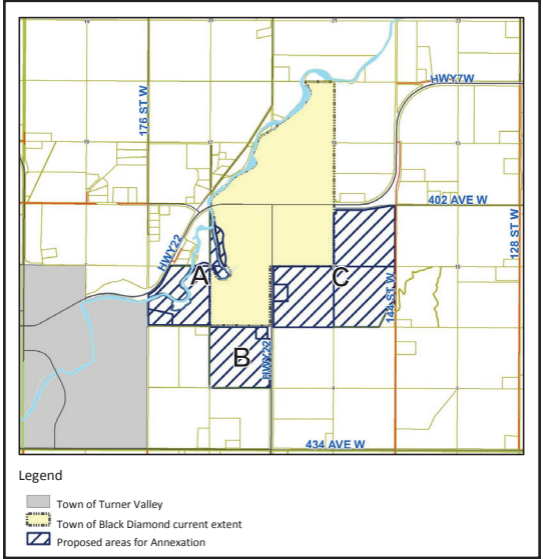




# NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Council of Foothills County will hold a non-statutory public hearing, regarding the following proposed annexation on WEDNESDAY, THE 22<sup>nd</sup> DAY OF MAY, 2019 at 3:00 pm, in the Council Chambers, Joint Administration Building, 309 Macleod Tr. S., High River, Alberta:



Foothills County Council has received an annexation agreement prepared by the Town of Black Diamond and endorsed by the Town of Black Diamond and Foothills County Annexation Negotiation Committee. The area of land under consideration for annexation from Foothills County into the Town of Black Diamond is approximately 766 +/- acres including 13 parcels, as shown on the map (above) and is described as follows:

**Annexation Area A – 152+/- acres (65.5+/- hectares), legally located in Township 20 Range 2 (W5M), portions of Section 8.**

**Annexation Area B – 156+/- acres (63+/- hectares), legally located in Township 20 Range 2 (W5M), NE of Section 5; together with the Government Road Allowance (418 Avenue W.) located directly south of the southern boundary of Section 8 Township 20 Range 2 W5M.**

**Annexation Area C – 458+/- acres (185+/- hectares), legally located in Township 20 Range 2 (W5M), NE, SE and SW of Section 9; together with the Government Road Allowance (402nd Avenue W.) located directly north of the north boundary of NE of Section 9 Township 20 Range 2 (W5M).**

Copies of the annexation agreement can also be mailed or faxed out upon request and may be inspected in the Joint Municipal Building in High River during regular office hours - Monday to Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

At the public hearing, Council will hear from residents who wish to make representation. Any person providing a written submission at the hearing must have twelve copies of same available at the commencement of the hearing. If you wish to provide letters in advance of the hearing, please do so two (2) days prior to the hearing date. No submission via telephone will be considered.
