Re: Fire Advisory

Foothills County has moved to a Fire Advisory. All open fires will now be allowed by obtaining a burning permit found on the Foothills County Website. Citizens are also reminded that obtaining a fire permit is mandatory at all times.

Although this is not a Fire Ban or Restriction, the County asks citizens to use extra caution and be extra vigilant when burning while this Advisory is in effect. As necessary, soaking the area adjacent to the open fire pits with water is recommended.

If conditions change, the County may impose a Fire Ban or Restriction at any time. If a Fire Ban or Restriction is imposed, you must immediately and fully extinguish your fire, all existing permits will become void and no new permits will be issued.
