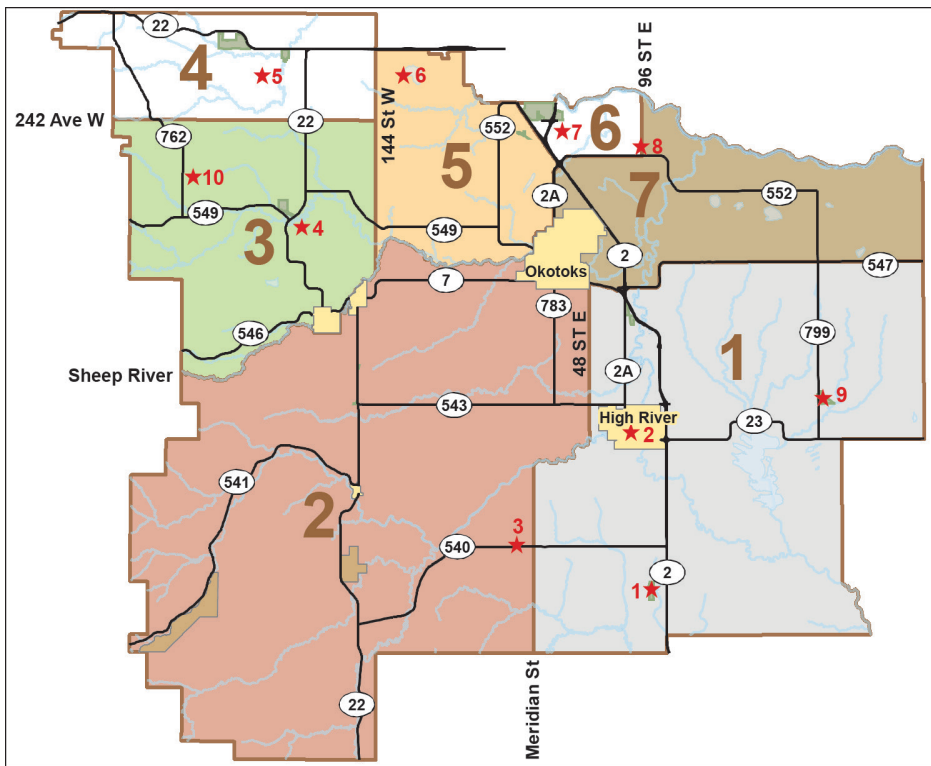


Notice of Election

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN:

- That an election will be held within Divisions 3, 6 and 7 of Foothills County;
- That an election will be held for the election of a Senate nominee for the purpose of the Alberta Senate Election Act;
- That a vote of the electors will be held on the following referendum question(s) under the Referendum Act:
 - Should Section 36(2) of the Constitution Act, 1982 - Parliament and the government of Canada's commitment to the principle of making equalization payments - be removed from the Constitution?
 - Do you want Alberta to adopt year-round Daylight Saving Time, which is summer hours, eliminating the need to change our clocks twice a year?

VOTER IDENTIFICATION

In order to vote, you must produce identification for inspection as required by Section 53(1)(b)(i). All voters must produce (A) one piece of photo identification with name and address that is issued by a Canadian government (federal, provincial, local, or an agency thereof), or (B) one piece of identification authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer under the Election Act with name and address.

Types of government-issued identification allowed under (A) must show the name, address and a photo of the elector and so examples of appropriate ID include:

- Operator/Driver's license
- Government photo identification card (for nondrivers) Types of Chief Electoral Officer-approved identification allowed under (B) must show the name and address of the elector and so examples of appropriate ID include:
 - Bank/Credit card statement or personal cheque
 - Correspondence issued by a school, college or university
 - Government cheque or cheque stub
 - Income/property tax assessment notice
 - Insurance policy or coverage card
 - Letter from a public curator, public guardian or public trustee
 - One of the following, issued by the responsible authority of a shelter or soup kitchen: Attestation of residence, letter of stay, admission form or statement of benefits
 - Pension Plan statement of benefits, contributions or participation
 - Prescription bottle insert
 - Residential lease or mortgage statement
 - Statement of government benefits, e.g. employment insurance, old-age security, social assistance, disability support or child tax benefit
 - Utility bill, e.g. telephone, public utilities commission, television, hydro, gas or water
 - Vehicle ownership or insurance certificate
