It's Not Right! is a program that addresses issues of older adult abuse, neglect and self-neglect in communities by engaging bystanders. It teaches citizens of all ages to recognize warning signs of abuse of older adults and to respond safely and supportively. True-to-life scenarios are used to facilitate discussion and to build skills so that participants are able to:

- **See it**, recognize the warning signs of abuse.
- **Name it**, by learning how to let your loved one know you are concerned.
- **Check it**, by asking questions and knowing how to help.

- ❖ Recognize the warning signs and risk factors of senior abuse.
- ❖ Recognize the role ageism plays in abuse.
- ❖ Recognize the impact of abusive behavior.
