

Welcome to Safe Communities Alert Network (SCAN)

This system a part of a new and improved regional emergency alert system is managed by the MD of Foothills. It is used to issue alerts to registered users, in the event of an emergency or serious incident. Other less urgent alerts may also be issued which may assist with increasing the preparedness of registered users for situations that could escalate or become disruptive. SCAN Alert enables us to provide you with the information you need to know.

YOU PICK WHERE.....YOU PICK HOW....

Alert messages will be sent to you about time-sensitive incidents happening in the MD of Foothills and other municipalities to the contact paths you identify. You get to choose the priority list to which contact paths the messages are sent when registering for the system. You will receive Critical Alerts and may choose to receive Information Alerts via several choices of contact paths, including:

- Home phones (landlines)
- Mobile / Cell phones
- Business phones
- Email
- Text Messages
- Everbridge Mobile App

CHOOSE YOUR ALERTS

SCAN Alert will be used to notify you about emergent, significant and time-sensitive alerts affecting the Municipal District of

Foothills. System administrators will send notifications regarding:

Critical Alerts:

Will be sent out to all registered users when:

- An immediate or imminent threat to the safety of MD residents and/or visitors is identified.

Information Alerts:

Will be sent out to registered users, who choose to receive these alerts, and include:

- Spring Runoff Advisories
- High Streamflow Advisories
- Fire Bans
- Water Issues / Restrictions
- Road / Bridge Closures
